FLOAT/NAIL/GLUE-DOWN SUGGESTIONS:

- Float or glue over a concrete slab, radiant heat, ceramic tiles, resilient tile or particleboard.
- Nail, float, or glue above plywood, 3/4" OSB, or a solid wood sub floor.



INSTALLATION EXAMPLES

FLOAT

A 1/16" bead of T&G Glue is applied to the bottom of the groove.



NAIL

Nails are inserted above flooring tongue and into the sub floor.



GLUE

Adhesive is troweled across the sub floor; flooring is installed above.
