- Ensure surface is clean and dry.
- If necessary, cut strip(s) to the appropriate size using clean, sharp scissors.
- This is an industrial-strength adhesive and may cause damage if removed.
- Do not use for load-bearing, vertical applications.
- If using for an underwater application, surfaces must be bonded when dry before being exposed to water.
- Greater coverage of bonding-surface area increases adhesive performance.

Surface Preparation & Application:

- 1. Remove one side of the oversized liner and firmly press DAP[®] ContactStikTM onto surface.
- 2. Rub finger over remaining liner to ensure adhesion.
- 3. Peel off remaining liner and press materials firmly together.
- 4. For Laminate Repair: Following instructions above, apply uniform bond pressure with a J-roller or similar device.

Product Removal:

- Insert knife between bonded surfaces and carefully cut DAP[®] ContactStikTM.
- Excess DAP[®] ContactStikTM can be cleanly removed with paint thinner or nail polish remover.
