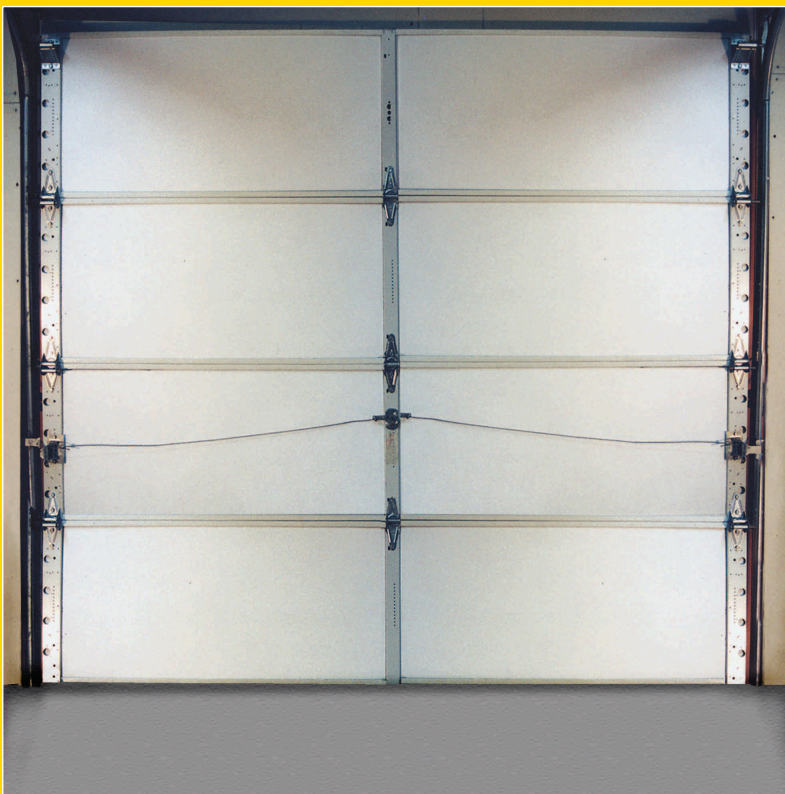

With the introduction of Insulfoam's Garage Door Insulation Kit, anyone can insulate their own metal door.

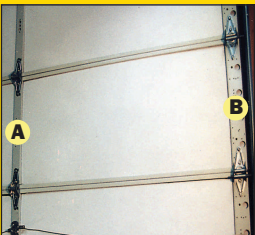

Installation Instructions



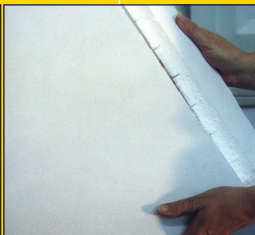
Tools required: straight edge, utility knife, tape measure & safety goggles



Measure length between vertical rail A to vertical rail B



Cut each insulation sheet to length



Break off the insulation where cut



Insert the excess insulation behind the vertical rails



Insert the insulation sheet between the horizontal & vertical rails
