Description:

Triangle's TriBond is the latest generation in chemical bonding technology. It is used as an adhesion promoter on any clean unpainted surface and is an integral part of the Liquid Porcelain refinishing system. TriBond is easily applied and fast drying. Triangle's trademark bleed proof hot-pink color lets you see immediately that you have full and even coverage. Wipe on to the slickest porcelain, fiberglass¹, steel, ceramic or masonry surface for dramatically improved surface adhesion.

TriBond also can be used on cast polyester "cultured marble"¹, ferrous and nonferrous metals for improved adhesion. On extremely glossy ceramic/porcelain surfaces an acid etch may be desired for maximum bond strength but in most cases removal of mineral deposits and soap scums is all that is necessary for long term adhesion.

Preparation:

REQUIREMENTS

- Surface and ambient temperatures must be above 60° F. and 5° F. above dew point during application.
- Surface must be completely free of all contaminants: all dirt, grease, oils, soap scum, mineral deposits, etc. Washing with Triangle's White Mountain Job Site Cleaner is recommended.
- Silicone caulking and surface protectants must be 100% removed; washing will not affect them.
 Any residual silicone will cause a paint failure.
- · Surface must be completely dry.
- Fiberglass and cast polyester "cultured marble" surfaces must be well sanded with 400 grit wet or dry sandpaper prior to application of TriBond.
- NIOSH approved organic vapors particulate respirator, solvent resistant gloves, eye protection goggles are required. An air supplied hood with head and face protection is recommended.

FILM DEVELOPMENT & THICKNESS:

TriBond is applied at extremely low levels. It does NOT form a notable film. It is applied in one coat to produce a chemically treated surface. Typical substrates are tub and tile surfaces such as ceramic, porcelain glazed or un-glazed tile and various metals. Actual application rates vary. Surfaces only need to appear briefly wet, not dripping. Recommend 800 sq.ft./gal. as a good general estimating figure.

MIXING-THINNING: None, use as is.

Application:

TriBond is designed for hand application by wiping on with a clean lint free cloth.

Apply the **Liquid Porcelain** overcoat as soon as possible after the TriBond has been applied. Reseal the TriBond container to prevent spoilage.
