Application

Apply with a putty knife. For shallow cracks, one application is sufficient. For deep cracks, two thin applications will produce better results. Allow compound to dry thoroughly between applications.

Sand smooth when compound is hard and dry.

Compound hardens within a few hours. Allow extra drying time during periods of high humidity and/or low temperature.

Decorating

Surface must be completely dry and free of dust and sandpaper residue. Apply any standard primer and decoration.

Cleanup
