

### Specification

### Part I - General

**1.1 General** - All materials and equipment necessary to install a custom double continment trench drainage system as specified and as shown on the working drawings shall be included.

**1.2 Related Work** - Work specified in other sections includes but is not limited to: Excavation and backfill, cast-in-place concrete, and mechanical equipment.

**1.3 System Description** - Custom double containment trench drain system.

**1.4 Submittals** - Manufacturer will submit, when required, shop drawings showing schematic plan of total drainage system listing all parts being provided with exact center-line dimensions suitable for installation. Copies of the manufacturer's recommended method of installation, assembly, and anchorage shall be submitted for review.

**1.5 Project History** - Manufacturer shall submit a list of projects installed during the past twenty years, if required.

**1.6 Warranty** - ACO provides a limited warranty of one year based on installation according to manufacturer's installation instruction data.

#### Part III - Installation

**3.1 Site Preparation** - Excavate area for channel placement wide enough and deep enough to accommodate the channel and a minimum of 6 inch (150mm) concrete encasement. Channels require a minimum of 6 inches (150mm) of concrete support on both sides as well as beneath channel. The finished level of the concrete surround must be approx. 1/8" above the top of the channel edge.

**3.2 Installation** - Channel sections are installed starting from the outlet or catch basins. Insert channels from above to allow ends to interlock. Channel sections shall be attached to rebar or suspended to obtain correct finished elevation. An ACO approved installer shall seal joints and system shall be water tested for leaks before pouring concrete. Cover top of channels with tape, plastic, or plywood strips to protect channel surface during concrete pour. Place concrete in a manner that will not dislodge the channels.

**3.3 Finishing and Clean-up** - Following final set of concrete, remove protection covering the top of channels.

**3.4** Install in strict accordance with manufacturer's recommendations and drawings.
