



Repeated wet/dry cycles do not diminish hydrophilic capabilities

The graph line with the ● markers shows the expansion when the product is under continuous immersion. Each ● indicates a weighing point.

The line with the ○ marker show the expansion when dehydrated and rehydrated. Each ○ indicates a weighing point.

A comparison of the two graph lines shows the product does not lose it hydrophilic properties when in a wet/dry condition. The hydrophilic agent is not flushed out during wet/dry cycles.
