TYPICAL APPLICATIONS

In today's technologically demanding environment, a little bit of dirt can cause a great deal of trouble. For instance, a speck of dust so small it can only be seen under a powerful microscope could throw a spacecraft's guidance system off sufficiently enough to cause the spacecraft to miss the moon by many miles. Because these microscopic amounts of foreign matter can create such problems, aerospace industries must meet superior standards of cleanliness. Clean Room™ systems were designed with this in mind.

There are a variety of applications for clean room systems. Use this chart to determine which material is appropriate for your space.

Laboratories	15/16" Steel
Pharmaceutical facilities	15/16" Steel
Automotive & aerospace	15/16" Steel
Computer rooms	15/16" Steel
Data centers	15/16" Steel
MRI (non-magnetic environment)	15/16" Aluminum
Hospitals	15/16" Aluminum or Steel
Food processing facilities	15/16" Aluminum or Steel
High-tech manufacturing	15/16" Aluminum or Steel
Spaces utilizing HEPA filters	1-1/2" Aluminum

The following applications typically have HEPA filter installations:

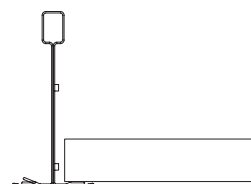

Semiconductor fabrication	Food processing
Disc drive manufacturing	Nanotechnology
Biotechnology	USP 797 pharmacies
Aerospace	Solar panel plants
Pharmaceutical production	Lithium battery plants

NOTE: HEPA filters require 1-1/2" flange because the filters are typically 23.625 x 47.625 and can weigh up to 60 lbs.

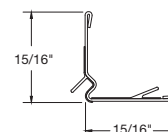
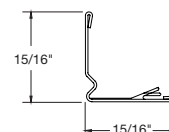
INSTALLATION CONSIDERATIONS

LIGHT FIXTURES

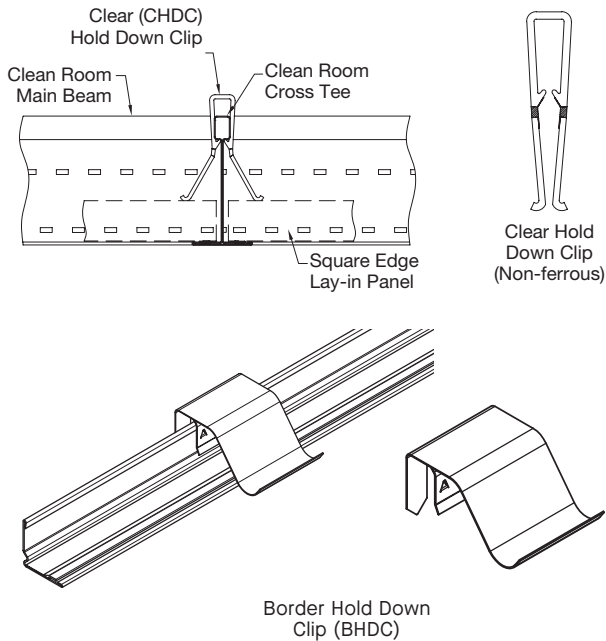
NOTE: 1-1/2" aluminum Clean Room suspension system has a 2" web height. Check with lighting manufacturers to ensure compatibility.

MAINTAINING POSITIVE PRESSURE

In the event that positive pressure is being maintained in the clean room, hold-down clips may be required. For Armstrong® Ceilings Clean Room system, the CHDC and BHDC clips may be used for that purpose. For CHDC, one on each side of the 2' x 2' panel and two clips at the third points on each 4' cross tee. For BHDC, one clip is recommended every 2' along the perimeter.

The CHDC Clip attaches to the top bulb of the suspension system to hold 1/16" to 3/4" lay-in panel in place; helps to prevent ceiling panel fluttering at entryways.

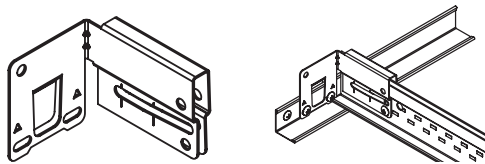
The Border Hold Down Clip (BHDC) attaches to the top of the perimeter molding to hold lay-in panels in place.



SEISMIC SOLUTIONS

The Armstrong® Ceilings 15/16" Clean Room™ Steel system is great for use in IBC Seismic Design Categories C and D, E, F. Please refer to the Seismic Rx® brochure for additional information.

BERC2 – 2" Beam End Retaining Clip – Allows you to create a code-compliant Seismic Design Category D, E, F ceiling installation while eliminating the need to use 2" wall molding or spreader bars.



NOTE: BERC2 Clip is only compatible with steel clean room. For aluminum, ALBERC2.
