FAST-SETTING POLYMER-FORTIFIED GYPSUM PATCH

KEY FEATURES

- Repairs minor imperfections in floors and walls
- High strength and crack resistant
- Apply up to 1/2" deep in one application

DESCRIPTION

Bostik Webpatch[®] D-9001 is a fast-setting, polymer-fortified gypsum based material designed for interior installation and may be used to patch floors, walls, and other surfaces. Webpatch[®] D-9001 may be used to fill up to 1/2" deep over properly prepared concrete, masonry, cementitious backer board, and structurally sound exterior grade plywood (interior/dry use only). When used properly, this product provides a fast-setting surface that will not check, crack or break up. Bostik Webpatch[®] D-9001 may be mixed with Bostik 425[™] Acrylic Latex Admixture Latex Floor Underlayment Additive instead of water for improved performance. Webpatch[®] D-9001 contains Bostik Blockade[®] Anti-Microbial Protection.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Read and understand data sheet completely before beginning installation. Follow applicable NTCA, ANSI and TCNA installation standards.

SURFACE PREPARATION

Surfaces must be structurally sound, clean and free of dust, dirt, paint, soap film, oil, adhesive residue, grease, curing compounds and other foreign material that could inhibit bonding. For best results, material and surface should be above 45°F (7°C).

MIXING

Add 25 lbs. of Bostik Webpatch[®] D-9001 to 6 quarts of clean, cool, potable water or Bostik 425[™] Acrylic Latex Admixture Latex Floor Underlayment Additive. Use 1/4 quarts of liquid for 5 lbs. of Bostik Webpatch[®] D-9001. **DO NOT OVER WATER.** Do not mix more material than can be used in 10 to 15 minutes. The material may be re-mixed; do not re-temper by adding more liquid. The pot life of the material is dramatically affected by jobsite conditions, the powder/liquid mix ratio, and temperature of the jobsite and materials; cold materials, substrate, jobsite and mixing water will extend the pot life.



APPLICATION

With the flat side of a trowel held at a 45° angle, work patch into surface filling all broken areas, depressions and cracks in the substrate. "Key in" but do not over trowel.

APPLICATION OVER PLYWOOD

Please refer to the proper flooring industry and APA standards for plywood subfloor installation and preparation. Clean and rough-sand the plywood. Due to the limitations of plywood as a substrate, it is not intended for use in wet interior, or applications subject to heavy/commercial traffic.

CLEAN UP

Wash tools immediately with water.

STORAGE/SHELF LIFE

Close container tightly and store unused powder in a cool, dry place. Product has a one-year shelf life.

LIMITATIONS

- The use of solvent-based sheet flooring adhesive over Bostik Webpatch® D-9001 is not recommended.
- For areas larger than 4 ft² with a consistent 1/2" depression, the use of Bostik SL-150[™] Self Leveling Underlayment is recommended.
- This product is not designed as a wear surface; an appropriate floor covering must be installed before it is open to normal traffic.
- This product is not recommended as an emboss leveler; use Bostik Webcrete[®] 95 mixed with Bostik 425[™] Acrylic Latex Admixture or Bostik Webcrete[®] 98.

Available in 25 lb. bags.
