

Tips on BRICKFORM® Liquid Release™ Application

DO

PREPARATION

Use only with adequate ventilation.
If using spray equipment, use a painters mask.

APPLICATION

Use in temperatures between 55° and 80°.
Only apply in sections of approximately 10-15 square feet.

DO NOT

PREPARATION OF SUBGRADE

Do not breathe vapors or mist.
Do not get in eyes or on skin.

APPLICATION

Do not trowel into the concrete surface.
Do not apply over the entire area at once.

SAFE HANDLING INSTRUCTIONS
