Stonecrops are a large family of over 600 species of succulents, very easily grown in quick-draining soils and sunny spots. 'Autumn Joy' ('Herbstfreude') is an upright cultivar, with grayish-green fleshy leaves and large domes of bright pink flowers which gradually soften to a coppery-pale pink through winter.

This recent introduction from Japan is similar in habit to "Autumn Joy," but its foliage is variegated, each fleshy leaf edged in white. And the flowers, which open in late summer, are pale pink, maturing white. Stonecrops are a large family of more than 600 species of succulents, very easily grown in quick-draining soils and sunny spots. The foliage is fleshy, and plants prefer well-drained soils and full sun. In the South, a number of rock garden species are at their finest during the cool fall, winter, and spring months and barely hang on during the summer. Partial shade is beneficial south of Zone 6. All tolerate drought and require little maintenance. Stonecrops are succulents that vary greatly in size and habit, from 2' border plants to prostrate ground covers. All prefer full sun and well-drained soil.





Forms a low-growing mat of trailing, deep burgundy-black foliage set with purple-red blooms in mid-to-late summer. This is an older variety but still outstanding as edging, in containers or the rock garden. Grow it with some Sedum Angelina for a dramatic, drought-tolerant combination.

This compact species is prevalent in the Columbia River Gorge. Rounded leaves on short, upright stems are like jade-green bubble-alga, maroon-red in winter. Bright yellow flowers in summer.

As the temperatures warm, the edges of the leaf take on a nice creamy gold border. The clumps are topped with sprays of bright yellow flowers held just above the foliage in midsummer.



It will tolerate most soil types, and is drought resistant. A great choice for beds and borders and excellent as cut flowers.
