### MANUFACTURING LOCATION

CETCO certifies that Swelltite is manufactured in Belle Fourche, South Dakota. If your project falls within a 500-mile radius of this location, the product is considered to be a locally produced material and can help contribute to earning Materials & Resources - Credit 5.1. Additionally, 100% of the bentonite used in the manufacture of the product is extracted within 500-mile radius of the Belle Fourche, SD facility and thereby Swelltite can help to contribute to earning Materials & Resources - Credit 5.2 within a 500-radius of Belle Fourche, SD.

### RECYCLED CONTENT

CETCO certifies that Swelltite is manufactured with a high percentage (50%) post-industrial recycled material content by weight from ordinary recovery of raw materials in the manufacturing processes of other products. Please note that this recycled content figures are not absolute. Day to day variations in manufacturing operations will result in minimal variations from the above listed figure. The product's high post-industrial recycled content can help to contribute to earning Materials & Resources - Credit 4.1 and Credit 4.2.
