SkyScape™ Sedum Cuttings

Sedum Cuttings

Description

Bulk Sedum Cuttings may be used for overplanting plug installations, filling in sparse areas, enhancing SkyScape Sedum Mat plant production, and for certain projects as the primary green roof planting. Cuttings are cultivated from the wide variety of SkyScape Sedum species (see next page for list) and can easily be installed by one crew member.

Method of Application

- Hand cast cuttings directly over a minimum 2" (51 mm) depth freshly-wetted growing media, at the required rate for the intended application. Use of a temporary hydro mulch, a lightweight erosion control blanket, or sand/topsoil or sand/compost mix can help hold the cuttings in place in windy conditions. Once broadcast, daily thorough watering of SkyScape Sedum Cuttings for the first several weeks will help encourage root establishment.
- Cuttings are provided in bulk bags [typically 20 lb (9 kg) or 50 lb (23 kg)].

Storage

- Deliver and store products in original packaging with manufacturer's labels and materials list intact and signed off.
- Store products in designated weather protected areas, elevated from ground and protected from environmental damage.

Shelf Life

- Sedum Cuttings should be installed immediately upon delivery.
- If inclement weather forces overnight storage, product must be placed in a cool, shaded (or air-conditioned indoor) location.

Coverage Rate

Standard distribution rate is 10 lb per 100 ft² (5 kg per 10 m²). Rates may vary with need [fill-in or overplanting rate could be as low as 5 lb per 100 ft² (2.4 kg per 10 m²)].

Clean-Up

- Gather and dispose all debris upon completion of work.
- Clean all surfaces and inspect final assembly for approval.
