Sedum Mats

Description

SkyScape sedum mats are grown on an artificial fiber carrier and within an engineered substrate vegetated with a variety of succulent groundcover species grown to at least 95% coverage upon delivery. The standard plant mix consists of 9 to 16 species of Sedum. The Sedum Mat mix is composed of proven succulent species designed to sustain year after year. The mix is composed of semi-evergreen, shallow rooting species (representing about 30-50% of the mix) and deep rooting, broadleaf, deciduous species (representing 50-70% of the mix). Careful selection coupled with proven propagation methodologies creates a sustainable vegetative solution for your green roof project. Lastly, SkyScape Sedum Mats are produced in accordance with FFL guidelines.

Method of Application

1. Following installation of the desired SkyScape Drainage Panel for the project, and installation of SkyScape Growing media at the appropriate depth, thoroughly wet the growing media with fine mist clean water free of debris, chemicals, etc.
2. Dependent on the design and roof layout, it may be best to start in one corner of the vegetative roof area, roll Sedum Mats out over the growing media, and abut seams tightly. Continue laying out mats and be sure to stagger seams throughout. Mats can be cut with a pair of large shears to fit around roof penetrations and protrusions.
3. Thoroughly irrigate Sedum Mats as you install per the recommendations found in the SkyScape Maintenance Guide; in dry climates and/or during extended drought-like conditions, more frequent irrigating may be necessary.

Storage

- All Sedum Mats should be installed on the day they are delivered. If mats must be stored overnight, they should be unstacked from their pallets and unrolled in a cool, shaded area, lightly watered, and installed the next morning.
- Deliver and store products in original packaging with manufacturer’s label and material list intact and signed off.
- Store products in designated weather protected areas, elevated from ground, and protected from environmental damage.

Coverage Rate

25 ft² (2.3 m²) per 4' x 6.25' (1.2 m x 1.9 m) mat

Clean-Up

- Gather and dispose all debris upon completion of work.
- Clean all surfaces and inspect final assembly for approval.

Precautions

Optimal installation windows for the SkyScape Sedum Mats are when ambient daytime temperatures are above 45 °F (7 °C) and below 85 °F (30 °C). If an installation must commence outside of this temperature window, please contact Holcim for additional installation recommendations.
