NO. 7 ASTM D-1227 Designation Change

Date: July 28, 1997

The American Society for Testing and Materials (ASTM) has changed the classification for specification ASTM D–1227 Type IV. ASTM has, in affect, eliminated the D–1227 Type IV classification. This elimination is a classification change only, and does not affect how or where the material is used. The Karnak materials affected by this change are Karnak #100AF Non–Fibered Emulsions, #220AF Fibered Emulsion and #920AF Fibered Emulsion Mastic. The new classifications are as follows:
