Cleaning Instructions

Overview

For best results, engage in a regular cleaning schedule to avoid dirt build-up. In general, any mild cleaner applied with a sponge, soft bristle brush or towel is considered safe and effective. Avoid using any cleaner or stain remover considered abrasive or containing chlorinated hydrocarbons or aromatic hydrocarbons.

Cleaning Agents

Mild soap solutions and the following cleaning agents have been tested and approved. Be sure to test any cleaning agent not appearing on this list in a small, inconspicuous area first.

- Murphy's Oil Soap
- Lysol
- Mr. Clean
- Formula 409 multi-purpose cleaner
- Fantastik multi-purpose cleaner
- Simple Green multi-purpose cleaner

Application Method

Apply the cleaning agent with a sponge, soft bristle brush or towel, working it across the surface in a scrubbing or circular motion. Rinse thoroughly using cold water.

For Graffiti and Other Stubborn Stains

If the aforementioned cleaning agents fail to remove graffiti or other stubborn stains, the following more powerful cleaning agents have been tested and approved for use with caution:

- Misty Vandalism Mark Remover
- Censor Vandalism Mark Remover

Please note: These powerful cleaning agents are flammable. Be sure to take proper precautions when using these and any other flammable materials.
