# SHELF LIFE

Two (2) years when properly stored in original container.

#### DESCRIPTION

A convenient stain or glaze product consisting of a 100% acrylic polymer clear base that is distributor tinted. AnticoGlaze CS produces beautiful aesthetics with varied degrees of mottling, coloration and glaze.

#### USES

AnticoGlaze CS is an antiquing stain product used to impart an 'old world' mottled look to stucco and EIFS exterior wall systems that are surfaced with an acrylic or elastomeric textured finish.

#### MIXING

Mix the contents of the AnticoGlaze CS pail with a paddle and low speed drill until thoroughly blended. Ensure all the pigment is well dispersed within the liquid. Periodic mixing with a gentle stirring action is recommended while using the product. If the product sits overnight, remix for one minute with the drill mixer before using.

- Do not over mix as this will create excessive air.
- Additives are not permitted.
- · Close container when not in use.
- Clean tools with soap and water immediately after use.

#### SURFACE PREPARATION AND CONSIDERATIONS

Finish surface must be clean, dry, sound and free of loose material, paint, efflorescence, contaminants and other coatings.

- Minimum application temperature is 50°F (10°C) and rising to maximum of 90°F (32°C)
- Ensure that windows and surrounding areas are masked, if contact occurs on windows, remove immediately with a damp cloth before sealer dries.
- AnticoGlaze CS is a freestyle product that produces a look that is greatly influenced by the application technique. It is best to apply the material thinly and repeat the application if necessary to create depth rather than removing excess product.
- A mock up is recommended to ensure a desired look is achieved based on chosen application technique.

#### APPLICATION

RANDOM SPONGE TECHNIQUE Dip a clean damp sponge into the AnticoGlaze CS product and apply the product to the wall in a random fashion, achieving a swirled or sponged-on look. Color, depth and contrast are achieved by distributing the product randomly with the final appearance in mind. SPRAY TECHNIQUE

Airless sprayer equipment recommendation:

- 1 GPM or 0.54 GPM airless sprayer.
- Tip size: .15 -.17
- Pump pressure and tip size per spray applicator preference
- Refer to manufacturer's instructions and tip offering.

Lightly and randomly spray the product on the wall with a low pressure sprayer. Back float the product using a float as needed to remove or soften the look of the color application. Frequently squeeze or rinse with water any excess product from the sponge float.

# DRY TIME

Approximately 3 hours at 73°F (23°C) but may vary depending upon the ambient weather conditions. Protect newly applied material from rain and temperatures less than 45°F (7°C) for at least 24 hours after application

#### LIMITATIONS

- Not for use on damp surfaces, below grade applications or on surfaces subject to water immersion.
- Apply only when air and surface temperature is between 50°F and 90°F (10°C and 32°C). Do not apply if surface or ambient temperature is expected to fall below 45°F (7°C) within 24 hours after application unless supplemental heat is provided during installation and drying period for at least 24 hours after installation and until dry.
- 3. Protect work from precipitation until dry.
- 4. Do not apply to frozen surfaces.
- Not for application over Tersus products. For questions regarding application over other products, contact technical services.

#### SHIPPING & STORAGE

- Protect materials during transportation to avoid physical damage. Store in a cool, dry place protected from freezing, extreme heat and direct sun. Store at no less than 40°F (4°C) and not greater than 85°F (29°C)
- Do not stack pallets.
