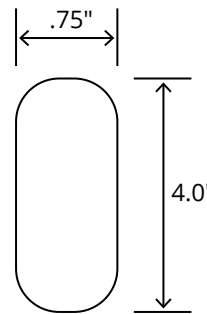

Notes

2. The centerline bend radius is based on inside corner radii shown in thickness chart.
3. Effective properties incorporate the strength increase from the cold work of forming as applicable per AISI A3.3.2.
4. Tabulated gross properties are based on full-unreduced cross section of the studs, away from punch outs.
5. For deflection calculations, use the effective moment of inertia.
6. Allowable moment includes cold-work of forming.
