


# Flat Tear Away® L Bead

For finishing around building components like windows and doors, where the drywall is sometimes butted too close to slip a return leg behind it - or when backing materials, like acoustical sealant, have been added - Flat Tear Away can be a lifesaver. Its tear-off strip serves as a protective mask to create clean finished edges.

## Installation Guide





#### **Before Installation:**

Measure, cut and dry fit the bead.

### Step 1:

Coat the bead with Trim-Tex 847 Spray Adhesive. Press the bead in place, applying pressure to the mud legs.

#### Step 2:

Staple every 6''-8'' using  $\frac{1}{2}''$  staples.

#### Step 3:

Finish with drywall compound. Remove tear-off strips prior to sanding.
