USE	Designed specifically as the fine finish for USG Ensemble® Acoustical Drywall Ceiling and Wall System.
BASIC INSTALLATION DATA	For complete installation instructions, see USG Ensemble® Acoustical Drywall Ceiling Guide (SC5075).
MIXING	The USG Ensemble [™] Spray Applied Finish must be mixed in the 5-gallon bucket prior to filling spray machine hopper. Use a 450-rpm electric drill and a high sheer 4-blade mixing paddle, blend until it is a smooth creamy consistency. Before any water is added, check the viscosity using a material thickness gauge provided by the spray equipment manufacturer (small steel ball on a cable). Place the ball on the Finish and let go, if the ball sinks into the Finish and is no longer visible in three seconds the material is ready to put in the sprayer. If the ball is still visible after three seconds, add water in 4-ounce increments and remix until the ball sinks in three seconds.
RECOMMENDED SPRAY EQUIPMENT	A hopper style texture sprayer and a spray gun, with a standalone air compressor will be needed to apply the USG Ensemble™ Spray-Applied Finish over the USG Sheetrock® Brand Ensemble® Four-Sided Taper™ Panels. Equipment specifications are available from your local USG Sales Representative.
APPLICATION	In order to achieve proper sound performance and appearance, the USG Ensemble [™] Spray- Applied Finish must be applied in a cross-hatch, half-lap spray pattern. Apply each coat very lightly with 36" min. gun clearance. Start in one corner and work progressively across the ceiling, immediately cross-hatch. After the first coat is applied wait until it is 100% dry (see drying time). Use a soft rubber squeegee trowel to remove any loose Finish from the ceiling. Repeat this step between each coat once dry. Apply successive coats until the desired appearance is achieved. The Finish can be applied directly to primed metal, plastic beads and trims. Maintain proper job site conditions and wear proper personal protective equipment (safety goggles, dust masks, coveralls) while applying texture.

Drying Time*: Can be recoated after 20–40 minutes at 75°F/50% R.H. conditions. Drying time is dependent on temperature and humidity of the space.

Storage: Store at 55-95°F (13-35°C) in a dry location. Protect from freezing, extreme heat and exposure to to direct sunlight. Keep container tightly sealed. Do not use if material is discolored or has an unpleasant odor. Unopened and unmixed Finish has up to 12-month shelf life under good storage conditions. Opened and mixed Finish has up to 6-month shelf life under good storage conditions. Rotate stock on a first-in, first-out basis.

*In less than ideal drying conditions, you may have to wait 60-90 min between coats. Check surface is dry to the touch before spraying subsequent coats. Using fans for air movement will typically help reduce drying time.
